Terms of Use

- During filming, visitors must comply with the visitor regulations and avoid disrupting general visitor operations as much as possible.
- The applicant guarantees that the necessary precautions will be taken and the general smoking ban will be observed within the buildings and on the grounds of the former Mittelbau-Dora concentration camp, as well as when filming individual exhibits. They shall be liable for any damage caused by the filming or photography work.
- No alterations are permitted on the camp grounds or in the historic rooms.
- Artificial lighting of light-sensitive objects may only be used in consultation with the responsible curator. In art exhibitions, the use of flash photography and halogen lamps is prohibited to protect the exhibits.
- If the copyright for images, films, texts, or works of art in exhibitions does not belong to the Foundation, the rights must be acquired prior to publication. The same applies to the right of visitors and Foundation staff to their own image.
- The creation of photographic, graphic, or other images—such as videos—is permitted only for private, educational, and academic purposes, as well as for the purposes of current news reporting. The Buchenwald and Mittelbau-Dora Memorials Foundation must be cited as the source.
- Use for any other purposes requires prior written permission. Any other form of use or exploitation, in particular any use for advertising purposes as well as the transfer to third parties, is expressly prohibited. News and photo agencies are exempt from this provision.
- A copy of the broadcast or a specimen copy of each publication must be sent to the Buchenwald and Mittelbau-Dora Memorials Foundation unsolicited.
- In the event of a violation, this permission may be revoked at any time. This permission must be carried on site and presented to memorial staff or security personnel upon request.

Additional Terms of Use for the Tunnel System

Permission to take photographs and film in the tunnel complex is granted subject to the following conditions. These are based on applicable mining laws and the Thuringian Ordinance on the Operation of Visitor Mines:

- The Foundation assumes no liability whatsoever for loss of or damage to materials or equipment. Entry into the tunnel complex is at your own risk.
- Visitors must not leave the visitor gallery or the designated areas. Only authorized personnel of the Memorial or its specially designated representatives are permitted to leave the secured areas.
- The Memorial will designate a supervisor whose instructions must be strictly followed.
- In the event of technical or mining-related emergencies, photography and filming must be stopped immediately, and visitors must leave the tunnel complex.
- Photography and filming, as well as the equipment used for these purposes, must not block escape routes or interfere with visitor operations while the memorial is open to the public. Photography and filming must be suspended upon the arrival of a group of visitors, and any disruption to the visitor experience must be kept to a minimum.
- Photography and filming involving stationary setups (camera cranes, spotlights, cabling, etc.) or that significantly restrict regular visitor operations are permitted only after special consultation and approval by the memorial's staff members responsible for safety in the tunnel complex. This is generally only possible on Mondays and outside the Memorial's opening hours.
- Any additional costs incurred for external supervisory staff, additional safety equipment, or other supplementary equipment will be billed to the signatory (including by third parties).
- The responsible staff member or security personnel must be notified each time a vehicle enters or exits the tunnels.
- In all other respects, all statutory, operational, and technical accident prevention regulations, as well as the Memorial's visitor regulations, apply.
